IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

The night before you start your rotation, page the ID Fellow at YNHH-SRC the night before your start date. To page from outside, dial 203-789-5990 and enter the ID fellow pager 17460. This is a consistent pager – no matter who the ID fellow at YNHH-SRC, they always have this pager. The resident should arrange to meet the fellow in the main lobby of the hospital. **See attached map.** Residents should always feel free to page or call Dr. Marjorie Golden with any issues.

All Yale Affiliated Hospitals Program (YAHP) Residents ARE REQUIRED to check in at the YNHH Housestaff Office at York Street Campus. Enter 330 Cedar Street, 2nd Floor, Tompkins 209) their 1st day of this elective rotation. The YNHH Housestaff Office will provide YAHP residents information about obtaining at YNHH temporary ID. You will also receive information about taking the YNHH shuttle to the YNHH-SRC (we strongly encourage using the YNHH shuttle service).

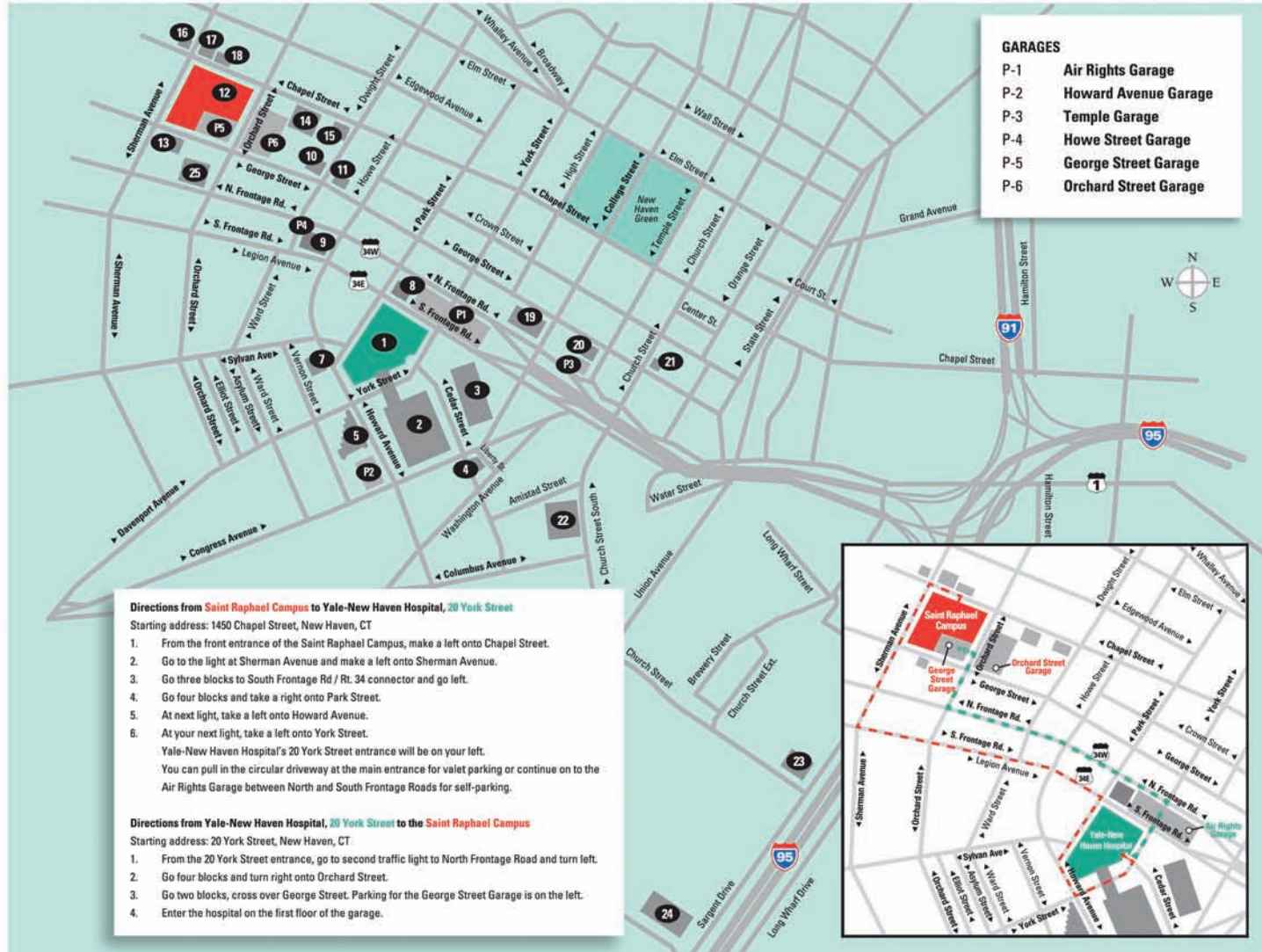

Directions from Saint Raphael Campus to Yale-New Haven Hospital, 20 York Street

Starting address: 1450 Chapel Street, New Haven, CT

1. From the front entrance of the Saint Raphael Campus, make a left onto Chapel Street.
2. Go to the light at Sherman Avenue and make a left onto Sherman Avenue.
3. Go three blocks to South Frontage Rd / Rt. 34 connector and go left.
4. Go four blocks and take a right onto Park Street.
5. At next light, take a left onto Howard Avenue.
6. At your next light, take a left onto York Street.

Yale-New Haven Hospital's 20 York Street entrance will be on your left.

You can pull in the circular driveway at the main entrance for valet parking or continue on to the Air Rights Garage between North and South Frontage Roads for self-parking.

Directions from Yale-New Haven Hospital, 20 York Street to the Saint Raphael Campus

Starting address: 20 York Street, New Haven, CT

1. From the 20 York Street entrance, go to second traffic light to North Frontage Road and turn left.
2. Go four blocks and turn right onto Orchard Street.
3. Go two blocks, cross over George Street. Parking for the George Street Garage is on the left.
4. Enter the hospital on the first floor of the garage.
