

Cardiology Heart Failure at YNHH- York

Elective Description:

This elective will introduce the resident to heart failure cardiology and the treatment of end-stage heart failure with left-ventricular assist devices and heart transplantation. Residents will be a member of the Heart Failure team, which includes a fellow and attending. Daily rounds will be held with the attending. Responsibilities of the residents include work-up of new patients (inpatients at Yale-New Haven Hospital and outpatients at the Yale CHF clinic), presentation to fellow and attending, communication of recommendations with primary care team, and appropriate follow-up. Conferences available to the resident include Fellows' Conference Monday, Wednesday through Friday at 7:30 a.m., Cardiology Grand Rounds/Clinical Conference (Tue 8:00 a.m.).
