

## Elective Description:

This 2 or 4 week elective is best taken during your second or third year of residency. You will rotate on a busy GI inpatient consult service, located at Y-NHH, where 25-30 new patients are evaluated and treated per week. You will work closely with the GI fellows as well as the inpatient GI attending of the month. You will see common and uncommon inpatient digestive diseases, including GI bleeding, GI cancers, inflammatory bowel disease and surgical diseases, just to mention a few. Time permitting, you may chose to participate in outpatient GI clinics, but this rotation is largely an inpatient one.

### Answer
