

Elective Description:

The Nephrology Consult Elective at Yale is a traditional in-patient elective that concentrates on hospital-based problems in water and electrolyte disturbances, acid-base disturbances, acute and chronic renal insufficiency, and dialytic modalities for their treatment, including hemodialysis, peritoneal dialysis, and CRRT. Residents participating in this elective will serve an active role in nephrology consultative activities on all services within the hospital, including the transplant service, all intensive care units, OB-GYN service, and the general med-surg floors. Residents will most often be the first renal team representative to see a new consult and will be expected to follow that patient on a primary basis for the team until all renal issues are resolved.

Clinical rounds will be conducted each day with a full-time faculty member of the section of Nephrology and the renal fellow. Participation in a weekly patient care review conference is also expected on Tuesday mornings. All residents are required to attend the regular renal conferences, including the Friday, 8:30 a.m. and Noon lectures, Tuesday 4:15 p.m. seminar and any other special conferences during their rotation.
