

# Radiology CT-Body at YNHH-YSC

## Elective Description:

The CT-Body rotation focuses on observing and learning the consultative aspects of diagnostic radiology and the role of cross-sectional imaging in patient care. The residents will gain an understanding of the risk/benefit and cost/benefit of CT with regard to radiation exposure and use of contrast media. Adult inpatient and outpatient CT-Body scans are the focus of the service utilizing both digital and 3-D imaging techniques for viewing. Specific body cases are reviewed on Fridays at 11:00PM and Wednesdays at 1:00PM. Other conferences of interest include weekly Lymphoma conference (Tuesdays at 8:30), GI Cancer conference (Tuesdays at 4 pm), Surgical M & M (Wednesdays at 8 am), and Melanoma conference (Thursdays at 8 am).
