

Emergency Radiology at YNHH-YSC

Elective Description:

The focus of this rotation is to familiarize the residents with the workings of Emergency Radiology so that they are better able to understand the communication requirements to obtain the appropriate studies more expeditiously on their patients. The exposure to the Emergency Radiology will enable the Resident to be more educated regarding choices for exams in various clinical settings as well as learn basic film interpretation. Residents will be exposed (figuratively speaking) to plain films, CT scans and ultrasound for ER patients. In addition there is one afternoon resident conference. Rotations can be for 2 consecutive weeks or 4 consecutive weeks.

Daily Hours: Flexible: Ideally any 8-9 hour period between 1 pm 2 am (it is most busy during these hours thereby providing the most learning opportunities)
